As part of our commitment to providing opportunities to play cricket in schools, Cricket Victoria would like to invite your school to be involved in the 2009 MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition.

Cricket Victoria has been conducting this State-wide competition since 1998. Each year an increasing number of schools from around Victoria entered. Last year a record 750 schools participated with 1,235 boys and 954 girls teams entered in the MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition.

To cater for the huge demand of the MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition there will be a total of 64 regional carnivals covering the width and breadth of Victoria and five Regional Finals Days.

The MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition is;

- **FREE TO ALL SCHOOLS,**
- Modified cricket that maximises participation,
- Played by boys and girls,
- Teacher friendly with easy to understand rules,
- Encourages team work, communication & leadership.

Schools that enter the MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition can choose to have a **FREE** clinic from a Cricket Victoria qualified coach prior to the competition. The clinic is aimed to teach the rules of the game, ground layout, strategies and tips.

The MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition is a modified one day cricket competition for boys and girls in Years 5 and 6. Schools attend their local regional carnival (see Page 3,4 & 5) and compete in a round robin competition against other local schools. (New country format outlined below)

MILO Kanga 8s maximises participation for all participants in a quick 16 over game (8 overs per team) that requires only 45 – 50 minutes to complete. A regional carnival runs along the following timeline:

- 9:30am: Schools arrive at local venue
- 9:45am: School briefing and rules refresher
- 10:00am: Round 1
- 11:00am: Round 2
- 12:00pm: Round 3
- 1:00pm: Finals
- 2:00pm: Presentations
- 2:15: Schools depart

(NB: Some regional carnivals may vary slightly)

Please note:

The winning girls and boys team from all of the 64 carnivals will now participate in a **Regional Final Day** where the winners of the region will have the opportunity to participate at the State Final to be held at the MCG.

Cricket Victoria will again offer a travel subsidy to those country teams that win through to the State Finals, as well as providing the eventual State Champions with a laptop computer.

Schools are asked to complete the Registration Form in the middle pages and return to Cricket Victoria by **Friday 9 October 2009**. After this date we may not be able to accommodate your school at its preferred venue or provide a clinic.

Q. How many teams can my school enter?

A. Every school has the option of entering up to three boys and three girls teams per carnival.

Q. Can I enter a mixed (boys & girls) teams?

A. Yes, a number of schools enter mixed teams when they do not have enough students for a separate boys and girls team. Mixed teams will compete in the boys division.

Q. What equipment does our school need to provide?

A. Schools only need to provide bats (plastic or wooden) for their teams and where possible one set of plastic stumps. All equipment should be clearly marked. Cricket Victoria will provide all other equipment.

Q. Can students use their own wooden bats?

A. Yes, students can use their own wooden bats or use bats (plastic or wooden) supplied by the school. All equipment should be clearly named.

Q. Can more than eight (8) players play per team?

A. The maximum number of players allowed on the field at any one time is eight (8); however a team may choose to have a player who bats and does not bowl and another player who bowls but does not bat, therefore ten (10) players per team. Alternatively players may be 'rostered off' for one of the round robin games. However it is recommended there are no more than ten (10) players per team.

Q. Can students from Year 4 play?

A. MILO Kanga 8s is a competition for Year 5 and 6 students however for schools with small numbers of students that want to enter they can use players from Year 4 to fill up a team if there are insufficient Year 5 and 6 students.

Q. Who scores and umpires at the regional carnivals?

A. Each school is required to umpire and score their games at regional carnivals and state finals. Teachers can organise a parent or an older brother/sister to do this role on the day. Some schools have established links with local secondary schools or cricket clubs to assist the running of their Kanga 8s teams.

Q. What are the dates for Kanga 8s in 2010?

A. With schools starting to plan for the 2010 school year towards the end of 2009 Cricket Victoria have set dates for the MILO Kanga 8s State-wide competition in Term 4 2010. Regional Carnivals will be held throughout November 2010. Registration details with dates for each venue will be sent to schools in early Term 3 2010.
