



St Johns Tecoma CC Junior Helmet Waiver

The St Johns Tecoma Cricket Club Inc Helmet policy reads as follows:

6.2 *Helmet policy*

All Junior Players are to wear helmets with full-face guards whilst batting at practice and during matches, unless, in the case of players in the Under17 team, parents sign a waiver for their son or daughter to bat without a helmet or faceguard.

The reason for this rule is to reduce the number of injuries incurred whilst batting, Before signing this it is hoped that Parents will discuss with the player concerned, and their coach, the players ability to evade deliberate short balls or errant deliveries that could result in injury.
