Also highlighted was the role of volunteers & being able to recruit more volunteers to lessen the load on a small number of committed members.

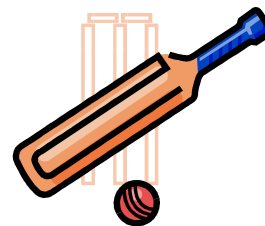
Policies such as providing free formal coaching courses for interested members & implementing a "Buddy" system for new volunteers is now a part of the induction for volunteers.

COACHES
