Message from Cricket Australia

Our thoughts continue to be with all Australian the communities impacted by the global coronavirus pandemic. These are uncertain times, but our number one priority is to the cricket communities that we lead and serve updated and informed.

On March 24, 2020, the Australian Government announced extended restrictions on social gatherings effective from midnight on March 25, 2020. Of particular relevance to cricket is that social sport activities are now prohibited throughout the country and will be enforced by state and territory authorities. All Australians should follow Government advice to stay at home unless absolutely necessary to leave. Whilst we love the game, we all must acknowledge that cricket it is not a necessary activity in the context of the global effort to control this pandemic.
