

CRICKET VICTORIA COVID-19 UPDATE (November 24, 2021)

NEW FAQs RELEASED

Not unexpectedly a few cricket clubs have been impacted by COVID-19 cases in recent weeks that have interrupted plans for training sessions and even matches. In some cases, the cases have resulted in the cricket clubs needing to organise for the facility to be shut down for a deep clean.

With approximately 1,000+ COVID-19 cases per day through the state at present, it is imperative that clubs maintain their vigilance to seek to minimise the likelihood of COVID-19 cases. As a result of the learnings gained over the past fortnight or so (& in line with the latest advice from the State Government) various new FAQs have been added. This takes the total FAQs to over 60 – so a strong likelihood that your questions may already be answered. The new FAQs can be found on the [FAQ section of the CV COVID-19 webpage](#) and the latest updates in recent days are:

- What are the top tips for clubs to consider re: COVID-19?
- What are the current quarantine / isolation rules re: COVID-19?
- What advice is available to people who test positive or are deemed to be social contacts?
- Who determines whether a person is a social contact when it comes to cricket?
- If an opposition player tests positive to COVID, would our players need to test & isolate until receiving a negative result?
- Can the club host after-training dinners / social events?
- Can a player who receives a negative COVID-19 result on match day (even after the match has started) play in the match?
- What happens to matches in the situation where a player in isolation receives a negative test result whilst the match is underway and has been in 'close contact' with players in the match in the preceding 2-3 days?

As noted previously, CV has dozens of resources (in various languages), various links to other useful information plus 60+ FAQs to assist, however don't hesitate to reach out to your local Cricket Manager should these not provide the guidance that you require.
