

# CHECKING THE VACCINATION STATUS OF YOUR PATRONS

**There is no requirement to check vaccination status of participants and spectators where a space is being used exclusively for community sport.**

- **Community sport** refers to competitions and training for the purpose of competition overseen by a state sporting association or equivalent governing body.
- Examples include **football** and **netball** competitions overseen by AFL Victoria and Netball Victoria, entry level participation programs such as **CricketBlast**, 'come and try' days or training for coaches and umpires.
- The **exception does not** extend to non-sporting activities associated with community sport such as **social nights, fundraising events** or **committee meetings**.
- Venues or sporting organisations may choose to impose additional conditions of entry above those required by the **Open Premises Directions** (e.g. a vaccination requirement for community sport participants despite the availability of an exception).
