HOW DO I COMPLETE REACCREDITATION?

This quick reference guide will assist you in completing your Community or Representative Reaccreditation program.



REACCREDITATION

Changes to the Laws of Cricket, interpretations and umpiring techniques are amended on a regular basis. To ensure an umpire is up to date with these changes a reaccreditation program is undertaken

The reaccreditation process is completed every four years via an on-line learning course and is undertaken for the level of accreditation you hold.

Getting Started

Step 1

To begin the reaccreditation process, visit https://www.community.cricket.com.au/umpire and click the 'log in' button

Step 2

- Enter your email address and Password
- If you have forgotten your password then click on 'FGRGOT"



Click on 'Explore Courses" – please note that it takes approx. 45 seconds to enter the Learning Management System.






The applicable reaccreditation course has been assigned to your Learning Home Page. Click on Open Curriculum

Once you have opened the curriculum then follow the process below






Please note that the process to open the Representative and Community Accreditation is the same for both courses
